On the day the CBSE Class X results were announced, the DPS Patiala family was filled with pride and excitement as every student cleared the board with flying colors. With a stellar 100% pass rate, Anika Goyal led the pack as the school's topper, scoring an exceptional 96.8%. She was followed by Angel Garg, who secured the second position with 95.6%, and Sana Verma, achieving third place with 94.4%. Gunnveer Singh closely followed with an impressive 94%.

























Elation filled the campus of Delhi Public School, Patiala as the CBSE Class XII results were announced, bringing pride and glory to the school. Students delivered an outstanding performance across all streams. Medical Stream was topped by Naveen Mittal (96.6%), followed by Inderpreet Singh (95.6%) and Sakshi Mittal (95.4%).

Non-Medical Stream saw Raghav Aggarwal (96.2%) leading, with Harsh Thapar (95%) and Jatin Singla (94.4%) close behind.
