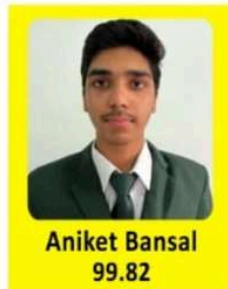

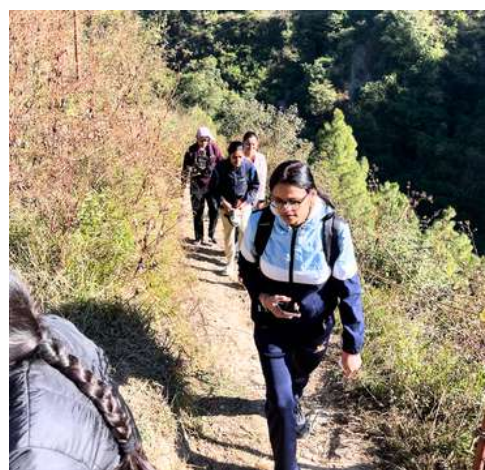


## IAYP students embark on an Adventure Journey
