CBSE Class XII Results 2025-26

DPS Patiala celebrated a proud academic milestone as its students delivered an exceptional performance in the CBSE Class XII Board Examinations 2025-26.

In the Humanities stream, Yashleen topped with 98.6%, followed by Avni Bansal (96.6%), Harsimar Singh (94.6%) and Shambhavi Siya (91.2%). Geetanshi Verma and Jaiveer Singh Arora jointly topped the Commerce stream with 94.8%.

In the Non-Medical stream, Sukhmilan Singh secured the highest score of 98%, followed by Tarini Gupta (96%) and Parnika Gupta (94.2%). Prachi Garg emerged as the Medical stream topper with 97%, followed by Anureet Kaur Sandhu (95.8%) and Mishti Gupta (95.6%).
